UFC provides flighted levels to fit all ranges of the developing youth player: the beginner, the intermediate and the advanced.



YOUTH DEVELOPMENT (Ages 6 to 10)

- Player remains on a KASL team and continues to compete in the KASL League.
- Player will receive 8 additional training sessions (4 in fall and 4 in spring) directed by a member of the UFC coaching staff.
- Player is exposed to United FC without the travel commitments of being on a United FC team.
- Player receives United FC practice shirt.

PRE-ACADEMY (Ages U6 to U8)

- Player is ready for an introduction to United FC and competitive soccer and is placed on a United FC team.
- Team competes in competitive league
- Light travel (in/around Kenosha to the suburbs of Milwaukee)
- 2 training sessions per week (fall and spring) and winter training
- 1 tournament (United FC BOTB tournament)

ACADEMY (Ages U9 to U10)

- Player is placed on United FC team.
- Team competes in competitive league.
- Some travel required (Metro Milwaukee area).
- 2 longer, more focused training sessions per week in the fall and spring and 1 optional training session per week in the winter
- 3 tournaments (including United FC BOTB tournament)

PREMIER (Ages U11 to U14)

RED

- Player placement is based more closely on talent, dedication and development.
- Team competes in highest level competitive league possible.
- Travel required.
- 2 training sessions per week in the fall and spring—1 optional training session per week in the winter.
- 5 tournaments (including United FC BOTB tournament).
- Possible State Cup involvement (U13 to U14 age groups).

BLACK

- Player is placed on United FC team.
- Team competes in competitive league.
- Travel required.
- 2 training sessions per week in the fall and spring—1 optional training session per week in the winter.
- 3 tournaments (including United FC BOTB tournament).

PREMIER HIGH SCHOOL (Ages U15 to U18)

RED

- Player has chosen soccer as their primary sport and is dedicated/committed to 9 months of soccer training.
- Team competes in highest level competitive league possible at State or Regional level.
- Travel required.
- 2 training sessions per week (fall/winter for girls, spring/winter for boys).
- 4 tournaments.
- Attend college showcase tournament.

BLACK (half year)

- Player wants to continue to develop soccer skills, but may also be involved in other sports and/or activities and can't commit completely to soccer.
- Team competes in competitive league.
- Travel required.
- 2 training sessions per week (fall for girls, spring for boys).
- 2 tournaments.
